Dr Joe Raheb

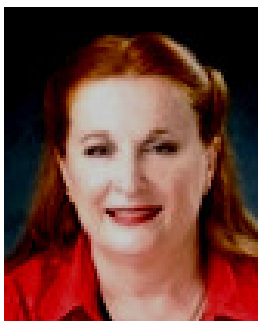
